- Response - Congratulations to the six Smyrna Engineers who were promoted to the rank of Lieutenant this past week, as well as the eight Smyrna Firefighters who were promoted to the rank of Engineer.

Public Works

- Spring Road Improvement Project - No work was performed this week on the punch list.
- Windy Hill Road Blvd. Project - Quotes have been requested from vendors for abatement and demolition of 901 and 1005 Windy Hill and 1041 Windy Hill Road has been put out for bid.
- Fire Station #2 - Building foundation wall is in place and contractor is backfilling foundation wall and bringing site elevations to grade.
- Reed House Site - Last of the concrete pours, driveway apron widening and small sidewalk pour were scheduled for Friday but due to the rain/snow/sleet mix will be postponed for Saturday. The site work is complete when this last concrete pour is complete.
- Paving Projects - The punch list remains at 75% complete. Croy engineering is working on adding two to three more streets that may begin paving next week to use the remaining funds from this year's paving project.
- Clifton Road Storm Sewer - The contractor was able to move the gas main and continued the project this week. The project is about 50% complete.
- Pretty Branch to Lee Street Sewer Replacement - The contractor is about 99% complete with the punch list.
- Sewer Replacement Under So. Cobb at Floyd -The contractor should complete all the sewer main pipe work on the east side, old Piccadilly side, of the So. Cobb Drive by next week. Then move to the west side to complete that side. The project is about 60% complete.
- Public works crews worked on curbing and landscaping work orders this week. Water/Sewer crews completed repairs from our last water main leak detection audit. Repairs resulted in an estimated savings of 300,000 gallons of water a year.

 - Manson Avenue Storm Culvert replacement- Design 0% complete acquisition 0% complete Hydrology complete Survey work complete

 - Public Works Detention Pond- Design 50% complete
