The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, masonry, specialty tension netting system, minor grading and finishes. **This is a Community Development Block Grant funded project and Davis Bacon Wage Scales apply.**

Quotations must be delivered to the Purchasing Department at the address listed above no later than the time and date indicated. Quotations received after this time will not be opened or considered.
